



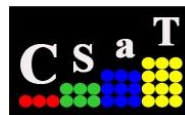

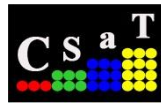

COURSE CONTENT:

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who have a defined and limited range of hospitality operational skills and basic industry knowledge. They are involved in mainly routine and repetitive tasks and work under direct supervision. This qualification provides a pathway to work in various hospitality settings, such as restaurants, hotels, motels, catering operations, clubs, pubs, cafés, and coffee shops.

There are no entry requirements for this qualification.

Before commencing in this qualification, students proficiency in language, literacy and numeracy will be assessed to determine what level of support is needed through the study program.

Duration: 11-24 months

QCE Points: 4 (based on a completed qualification)

This qualification is currently delivered via a combination of **online** and **classroom** delivery. Assessment methods will include written and observation.
